- Completed application
- Academic Transcripts – Upload "Unofficial" pdf copies of your transcripts from all college(s) attended using your student on-line portal. Your current institution (e.g. Univ Hawaii) may offer a combination of Transfer & Campus transcripts in a single document. Be sure all your academic semesters are included in your uploaded transcripts.
- 2022-23 Estimate Family Contribution (EFC) (page 1 on the Student Aid Report (SAR) from Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Your FAFSA must be submitted and processed in order to obtain your 2022-23 SAR
- Written Personal Statement
One-page, single spaced, 12 pts, maximum of 500 words.
 - We would like to learn a little more about you. Here are some things to think about as you write your short essay. Please limit your essay to one page, single-spaced, no more than about 500 words. These are just ideas starters. You don't need to answer these questions.
 - For both Option 1 and Option 2
 - How have you changed personally or academically since you began your college career?
 - What have you learned about yourself as you've transitioned to becoming a college student?
 - Option 1
 - Tell us about your college experience so far. How has it been compared to what you thought it would be like?
 - Tell us about a time you had to work with a group to get things done.
 - What are you most looking forward to next year? What are you least looking forward to?
 - Option 2
 - What made you decide to pursue a college degree at this time in your life?
 - What is it like balancing your work/home life with school?
 - How do you think you are different as a student now compared to if you had gone to college right after high school?
